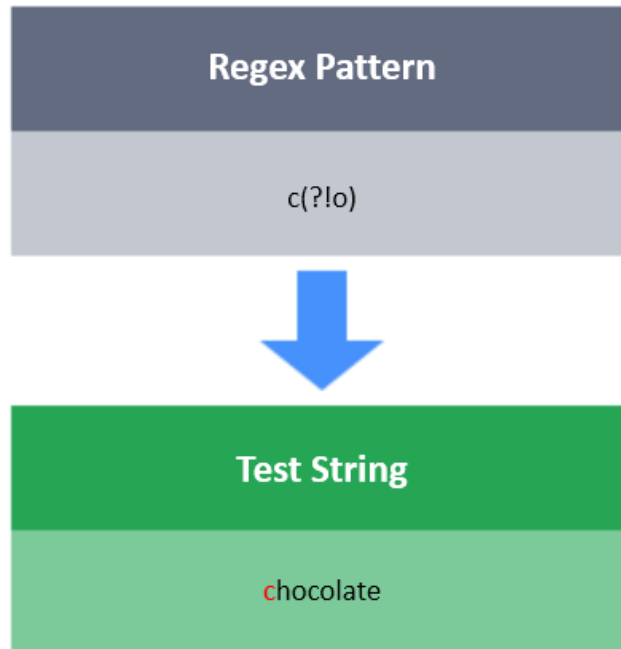


`regex_1(?!regex_2)`

The negative lookahead (`?!`) asserts `regex_1` *not* to be immediately followed by `regex_2`. Lookahead is excluded from the match (do not consume matches of `regex_2`), but only assert whether a match is possible or not.



*In above image Regex Pattern is matched with the Test String.*

## Task

You have a test String  $S$ .

Write a regex which can match all characters which are not immediately followed by that same character.

## Example

If  $S = \text{goooo}$ , then regex should match `gooo`. Because the first `g` is not followed by `g` and the last `o` is not followed by `o`.

## Note

This is a regex only challenge. You are not required to write a code.
