## Python: Division

## Task

The provided code stub reads two integers, $a$ and $b$, from STDIN.
Add logic to print two lines. The first line should contain the result of integer division, $a / / b$. The second line should contain the result of float division, $a / b$.

No rounding or formatting is necessary.

## Example

$a=3$
$b=5$

- The result of the integer division $3 / / 5=0$.
- The result of the float division is $3 / 5=0.6$.

Print:

0
0.6

## Input Format

The first line contains the first integer, $a$.
The second line contains the second integer, $b$.

## Output Format

Print the two lines as described above.

## Sample Output 0

1
1.33333333333
