

# Ruby Hash - Each

You've seen the [control structure](#) `each` used on an array. Similarly, it is available for the `Hash` collection, as well.

On `Hash`, it works in two ways.

Consider the example

```
user = {"viv" : 10, "simmy" : 20, "sp2hari" : 30}
```

Using `each`, each element can be iterated as

```
user.each do |key, value|  
  # some code on individual key, value  
end
```

or

```
user.each do |arr|  
  # here arr[0] is the key and arr[1] is the value  
end
```

Your task is to use `each` and iterate through the collection and print the key-value pair in separate lines.

## Hint

```
puts key  
puts value
```
